20 (Action) MARY DISAPPEARS—PRINCE ALONE..... Gigue (Gretry-Mottl) ..... 1½ Min.  

21 (Action) MARY AND PRINCE ON HORSE..... All Aboard for Heaven (Meyer)..... 1 Min.  

22 (Action) THEY DISMOUNT IN FRONT OF HOTEL.... Entr'acte Gavotte (Gillett)..... 1¼ Min.  

23 (Title) I'M NOT GOING TO BE MARRIED..... Oh Boy, What A Girl (Green)..... ¾ Min.  

24 (Title) I'M SORRY SIR ..... Skaters Galop (Fahrbach)..... 1¼ Min.  

NOTE: Catch punches, falls, crashes, etc.  
 25 (Action) HE AND MARY SKIP OFF..... I Want A Lovable Baby (Henderson)..... 1 Min.  

26 (Action) OFFICER AND SOLDIERS APPEAR..... Nibelungen March (Wagner) (Trio)..... 1¼ Min.  

27 (Action) FOLLOWING TITLE: "THE KING IS DEAD, LONG LIVE THE KING"..... All Alone (Berlin)..... ¾ Min.  

NOTE: Play "PP" con sordini strings only.  
 28 (Title) THE CORONATION ..... Festival Overture (Mouton)..... 1½ Min.  

NOTE: Play first movement only.  
 29 (Action) ANARCHIST THROWS BOMB..... Festival Overture (Mouton)..... ½ Min.  

NOTE: Start at Allegro Agitato (8), and play right ahead; catch explosion.  
 30 (Title) WE SHALL NOW SING..... God Save the King..... ¾ Min.  

31 (Title) AS LONG AS THE SUN SHINES..... Let It Rain, from "Sky High" (Dyson)..... 1 Min.  

NOTE: Rain effects.  
 32 (Title) THANK YOU FOR STAYING..... Joyeuse Alert (Fosse)..... 1 Min.  

33 (Title) YOUR MAJESTY, THIS IS NO WAY..... Yes, Sir, That's My Baby (Donaldson)..... ¾ Min.  

34 (Action) BOMB LANDS—DOG PICKS IT UP..... Ruy Blas (Mendelssohn)..... 4 Min.  

NOTE: Catch Prince whistling—explosion.  
 35 (Action) AFTER BOMB EXPLODES—LEAVE ROOM... 5d Hurry or Furioso "Synchronizing Suite No. 5" (Lake)..... 1 Min.  

36 (Title) WE HAVE JUST ELECTED YOU..... Liberty Day (Zamecnik)..... ½ Min.  

37 (Action) RAIN ..... Repeat No. 31. "Let It Rain"..... 1 Min.
