 NOTE: "That Night In Araby", (No. 4) is a sequel to "The Sheik of Araby". Both numbers are published by Waterson, Berlin and Snyder and should be used in this score adding to the music a beautiful and necessary earmark in contrast to the dramatic illustrations.
 For exit, play both choruses: "That Night In Araby" and "The Sheik of Araby".
